INCREASE IN MEMBERSHIP DUES EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2017

An increase of \$ 5.00 will come into effect for all membership types that come due as of March 1, 2017, (even if you pay your dues in February). The Boat Rack fee will increase by \$ 15.00 per year.

The new rates (as of March 1, 2017,) are:

There will not be any changes in membership dues for Youth or for a Sponsored Child.

POACHING

Poaching is a serious problem. Only club members wearing their valid membership cards, and their guests, are allowed to fish on the pond.

If you see anyone fishing with no visible membership card, ask to see proof of valid membership. Club members who do not display their valid membership card should expect to be told by the caretaker or any member to immediately stop fishing. Non-members caught fishing on club property could be charged with trespassing and poaching.

It is a WOFGPA long-standing tradition that the old Executive body serves dinner to the new Executive, the club members and their guests.

DANGER – THIN ICE

If you choose to ice fish, please stay clear by at least 15 metres of the skating rink area, which is between the main and south docks.

Please stay on the docks to fish until the ice has completely formed and is at least 10 cm. (about 4 inches) thick. A minimum of four inches (10 cm.) of CLEAR ICE is necessary to support the weight of one person. If you are fishing with a partner or a group, additional ice thickness is required.

A windmill has been installed to aerate the water. If ice forms around the windmill platform, it will be thin. Please keep clear of the windmill platform as the area around it <u>will never</u> be deemed safe to support any weight, including your pet's weight.

Do not let your pet run loose on the property, including the ice. It is the club policy that all dogs be on leash and under direct control of their owners.

The ice conditions are checked frequently. As ice conditions can change from day to day, you are asked to use your own judgement regarding ice safety. Exercise caution at all times on pond ice. When in doubt, stay off the ice.

Always use the "Buddy" system and never venture out alone.

Mark your fishing holes with a flag or small branch – for safety and consideration of others.
