## President's Message

On Sunday June 8<sup>th</sup>, we will be hosting our annual Kids Fishing Derby. This event is open to all Children 12 years old and under. The main objective of this derby is to teach our future members the fine art of fishing.

With this in mind, we are going to try a new format this year, which should help the children in recognizing different fish species and how to angle for them. At the Derby, each child will be given a Brochure with different pictures of fish that are in our pond and suggested baits to use to catch them. Each fish species will be assigned points from 1 to 40. A few of the examples in the scoring scheme are: Bluegill - 1point, Bass - 3 points, or Carp which are valued at 40 points. This way the children will be encouraged to angle for different fish and will definitely learn to identify the different species of fish.

We also will have casting clinics for the children and a chance for the juniors to try fly rod casting. As usual, there will be food and refreshments available. Please bring your children, grandchildren and their young friends for an enjoyable day at the Pond.

Please remember all children must have adult supervision.

As was mentioned in last month's newsletter, we have quite a lengthy waiting list for people that would like to become members at our club. At the April 10, General Meeting, the Executive decided that all new prospective members must come to a General or Executive meeting to put their name on the waiting list by seeing myself. This would introduce them to our Club and its operation. We set this time to keep the time for volunteers at a minimum.

As well, I informed all members that from now on, all renewals and sticker distribution would be done prior to Club meetings from 7:00 till 7:30 pm. All membership badges must have a valid renewal sticker, which will allow you to enjoy fishing privileges. The reason for this decision by the Executive after discussion with the members present at the April General meeting was to get more members participating in club affairs through their attendance at the meetings. I hope that we can get people out at least once a year.

If there is good reason that you cannot get to the meeting to pay your membership dues, please contact me for other arrangements.
